Chartered Accountants Medical Aid Fund (CAMAF) Family Practitioner Network 2017

In 2017 CAMAF will be introducing a Family Practitioner network. This network will be set up and run by the Independent Practitioners Association Foundation (IPAF).

We invite you to increase your practice visibility among CAMAF members by becoming a family practitioner network member.

Family Practitioner network rates are set out in the below table.

		Increase on 2016 rate
2016 non-network consult rate	R331	
2017 non-network consult rate	R340	2.6%
2017 network consult rate	R375	13.2%

- Doctors servicing CAMAF patients will receive a fee enhancement of 2.6% on the 2016 consultation fee, irrespective of whether or not they join the network.
- Doctors who elect to become part of the new CAMAF Family Practitioner Network will receive a further 10.6% increase on the non-network rate for the consultation codes of 0190, 0191, 0192.
- Network doctors will thus earn a combined 13.2% enhancement to the 2016 consultation fee for codes 0190, 0191, 0192 for 2017.

There are many benefits to becoming a CAMAF Family Practitioner Network doctor, including: increased practice visibility, higher consultation fees, potential for more referrals and receiving the online profiling which will give you a better idea of how your practice compares to other family practitioner practices on cost and quality.

We look forward to your participation in the CAMAF Family Practitioner Network.
